

HOW DO I BECOME A 4-H VOLUNTEER?

Thank you for your interest in becoming a 4-H leader.

The process for leader certification is as follows:

1. Complete an application form and mail it to the Santa Cruz County Extension Office.
2. Have your references return the reference forms directly to the Extension Office. We will need at least three.
3. Interview conducted by Program Director (Dean Fish). Please call the Extension Office and set up an interview before the certification workshop.
4. You view the Youth Protection video.
5. Review Leader Behavior guidelines. (1 page)
6. Attend Leader Certification Workshop. Listed on this website is a calendar that states when the Workshops will be held or you can call the Extension Office.

All forms that are listed above can be obtained from this website or you can call the Santa Cruz County Extension Office and we will mail you a packet.
